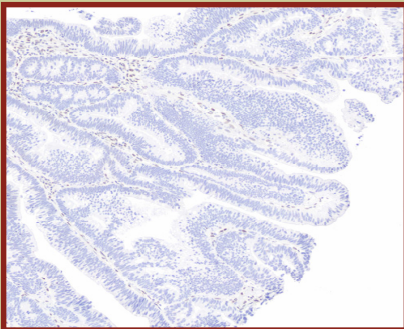
Colorado GI Pathology offers three distinct options to meet your needs.

Option B: Colorado GI Pathology performs lab tests and our pathologists provide you with reports.

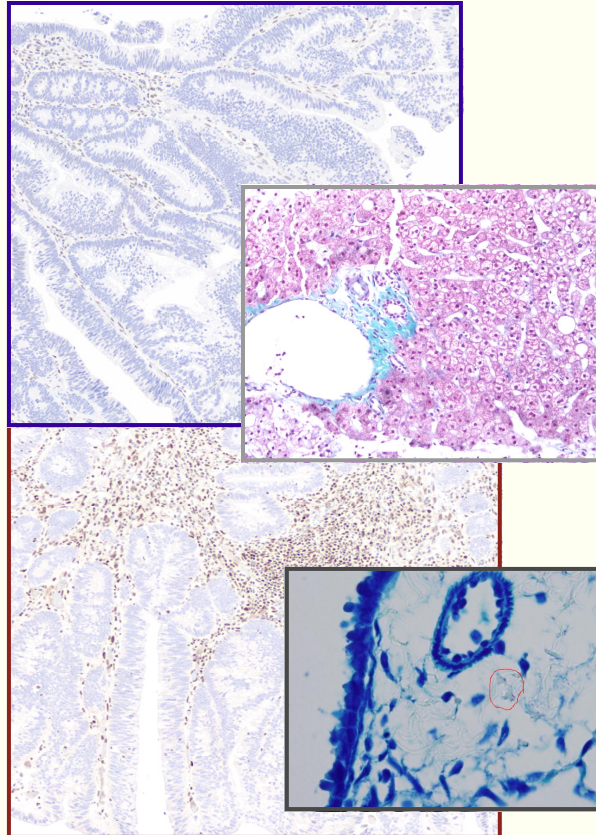
Option C: Ownership Arrangement, where you take a share ownership in Colorado GI Pathology and bill out.*

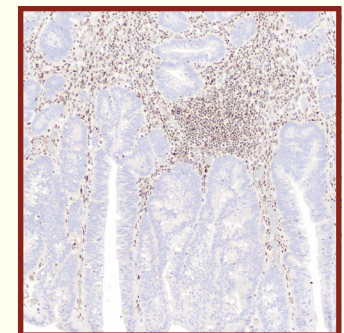

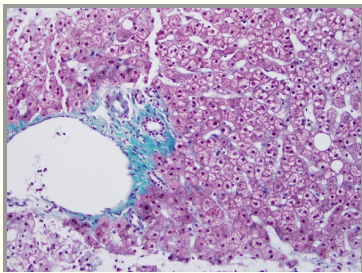

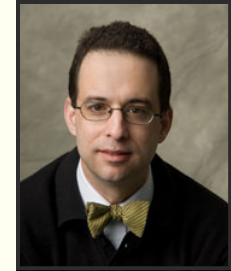
